

# Be ShockProof! - use electricity safely at home

On the other side of this sheet is a picture of a living room. It might look safe for the people and the pets who are there, but it's not. There are ten different ways they might be electrocuted. Colour in the picture and see if you can find all ten!

*Here are the answers:*

- **The baby chewing the computer cord.**  
Never put anything which uses electricity in your mouth.
- **Child standing on power point and swinging on light.**  
Never stand on or pull an electrical fitting, or a power cord.
- **Vase on the television.**
- **Extension cord by the coffee cup.**
- **Flower pot on the shelf by the radio.**  
Water and electricity don't mix.
- **Smoking plugs near lamp (double adaptor overloaded).**  
Only put one plug in each socket.
- **Computer cord across the doorway.**  
Never leave power cords where people might trip over them.

- **Loose wiring on the television.**  
Never touch an exposed wire.
- **Grandpa's fishing rod in the powerlines (in his dream).**  
Never let anything you are carrying touch a powerline. And the last one is really hard to find ...
- **Open socket plug where the boy is swinging.**  
Use a safety plug when power points are not in use.

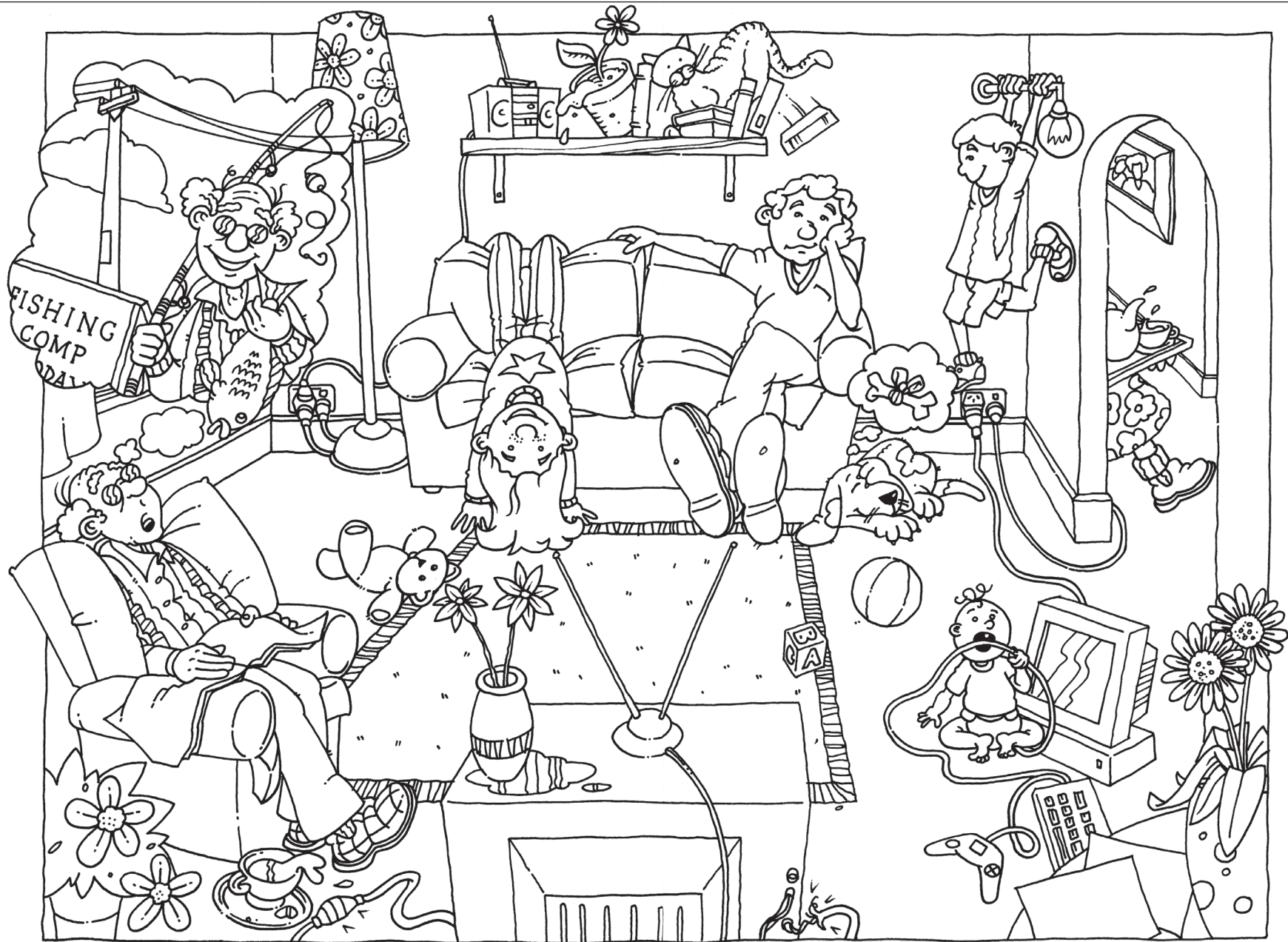
*Do you know what to do when someone is electrocuted?*
